I have lived in the area over 13 years and the air quality, traffic and just over all quality of life has gone downhill. It is bad enough that Sketchers was approved but now this. I am the president of a mortgage company in Moreno Valley so I am very much in touch with the real estate market. I can tell you 2 homes in our area just went up for sale and they were the original owners of 25 years. These people are selling before the proposed warehouses were approved. Nobody wants to live or raise a family in a warehouse district. More people are contemplating the same thing.. People moved out there for a reason and that was that it was rural and they could raise their kids in a safe environment. It is not that way anymore. Just this week I passed over 10 big rigs running up and down Redlands Blvd with no knowledge is against the law. The traffic has increased tremendously. Any additional warehouses will decrease the quality of life. I strongly urge you not to approve this project. There are plenty of other areas in Moreno Valley that are already developed for this kind of development.
